Extension Activities / Outreach Programmes through NSS

KKM College, Manwat regularly organizes extension activities and makes its students actively participate to promote College-neighborhood-community network through NSS and recently granted Community Education Centre. In other words, the College keeps an association with community welfare issues and strives to deliver whenever the condition demands. It has more than fifty-year-old National Service Scheme unit; working with 'Not Me but You' objective. The College management has been keen in terms of coordination of the unit with the adopted villages. The various community programmes in respective villages resulted into reputed awards and recognitions such as 'Nirmal Gram Award' for these villages. Therefore, the villages like Hattalwadi, Atola, Sawli, Savangi, Nagarjawla, Kolha and Rudhi have an unshakable bond with the College in general and the NSS unit in particular. Following is the report of community work for last five undertaken by the NSS unit. It has been an outcome of our social responsibility and also our genuine efforts in instigating flame of social concern in the minds of our students.

The College believes that for the holistic development of students, to become good citizen of the Country, there should be a perfect blend of curricular, co-curricular and extracurricular activities. In the present academic year, the NSS unit of the College took initiative to collect funds for Kerla and Kolhapur flood affected people. Rallies were arranged to urge community members and, as a result, more than one lakh rupees were collected. Which were later transferred to PM Fund. On the other hand, the students have been sensitized on social issues like: gender-equality, child-marriages, religious-harmony, blood-donation, road-safety, cleanliness, literacy, voter-awareness, sustainable-environment, social forestry, water-conservation etc. The NSS unit took lead role in collaboration with Health Department,

Parbhani to observe Leprosy Eradication Fortnight (24/09/2018 to 09/10/2018) to inculcate health awareness among the volunteers and other students of the College. Police Station, Manwat and NSS unit of our college conducted Girl Safety Programme on 09/10/2018. Nehru Yuva Kendra, Parbhani and NSS KKM College hosted this self-defense training camp for girls.

Shashank Rahula, Nehru Yuva Kendra, Parbhani, was present as the chief guest for this event. In his speech, he told the youth about the responsibilities of the youth. National service is public service. Youths should voluntarily perform various tasks in disaster management. They should serve the nation selflessly; many social problems should be solved through National Service Scheme. He appealed the youth to come forward. At the same time, Smt. Sarita Yelpulla madam explained how to prevent violence against women and the importance of karate training and self-defense. Various types of self-defense training were given through demonstration. For this, College girls participated spontaneously.

The NSS unit adopts a village for three years and addresses various social issues throughout the year and concentrates on specific issues in special one-week residential camps. The special camp, in collaboration with Village Council, Savangi and NSS Department, SRTM University, Nanded for the present academic year held between 13-19 Dec, 2018 at Savangi, Tal Manwat. The unit organized Blood Donation Camp 18/12/2018 in collaboration with Hujur Sahib Blood Bank, Nanded.

Three of our students, Prem Chavan, Akash Khandare and Vikas Survase took active part in 'Yuva Mahaiti Dut' programme conducted by Government of Maharashtra and UNICEF. These students were with awarded with certificates on 11/08/2019 by the Chief Minister of Maharashtra.

The activities, organized under the NSS, have empowered students to effectively tackle the situation during natural disaster and developed in them, a deep sense of social and civic responsibility. The student volunteers have conducted rallies in the town and in the villages nearby for cleanliness under Swachh Bharat Abhiyan. They cleaned the public places like bus stand, market place, temples and important chowks. The initiatives created

NSS Foundation Day was celebrated at Savangi on 24/09/2019.

Voter Awareness programme in collaboration with Manwat Tahasil was organized to aware the new voters and also to undertake registration programme on 11/10/2019. International AIDS Day is being celebrated all over the world on December 01. Our NSS unit in collaboration with Pharmacy College, Manwat carried out AIDS Awareness Rally through the entire town. The rally was a mark of social concern of our institute and its bond with the community. More than 300 students took active part in the rally. NSS Special Camp (160 students) was organized between 8 -14 December 2019. Intellectual sessions, field work and cultural activities took place during the week. The camp helped the students in enriching their environmental as well as social awareness and also their responsibility in making of the nation as youth. With the help of Blood Bank, Parbhani blood donation camp was organized on 25/0/2020. 07 volunteers donated their blood in the camp.
