Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the college organized one day faculty development Programme on National Education Policy 2020 on 13th September 2022. The event was hosted for the teachers working in schools and colleges of Pathri Taluka Shikshan Prasarak Mandal, Manwath. The implementation of NEP is round the corner. But there seems to have least awareness among teachers regarding actual nature of the policy, its impact, the challenges, process and opportunities it offers. There is no excuse for any of the educational institution of withdrawing their interest. Hence a proper knowledge of the policy and its implications is needed to the stakeholders and more particularly to teachers as they ought lead from the front in the process of actual implementation.

Prof. Dr. D.N. More, People's College, Nanded and Dr. Balaji Chirde, Head, History Department of People's College, Nanded were invited as guest speakers to enlighten the teachers on diverse aspects of the policy. D.N. More covered almost all the aspects of the policy. He emphasized on the challenges in actual implementation of the policy. He added that the policies introduced before the present policy had their own merits. The point of consideration is how it is implemented actually. He explained further that how HEIs are going to be Multidisciplinary centres in nearest future.

In the second session of the Programme Dr. Balaji Chirde argued on challenges and opportunities offered by new education policy in terms of primary and secondary education in our country. Both the speakers agreed to a great extent that the **National Education Policy-2020** is going to transform the existed educational system right from its root.
